## PEER REVIEW POLICY

This scientific publication is reviewed by a panel of outstanding scholars and academics, experts in the line of architecture and education. The evaluation criteria to be considered before publication refer to:

- **significance**: is the theme significant for the research in the field?
- **relevance**: is the article relevant for the current trends in the research on the field?
- **originality**: does the article bring anything new to the research in the field?
- **sound research design**: is the research thoroughly conducted?

accurate presentation: is the article well structured, are all the required elements present (e.g. abstract, key words, introduction, results, conclusions)?

A researcher who has done extensive work on a case should organize publication so that each report gives a well-rounded account of a particular aspect of the general study

- **clarity**: the authors shall assume responsibility of the quality of the English language of the articles
- **ethical issues**: it is unethical for an author to submit the same research paper to more than one journal, unless it is a resubmission of a paper rejected by or withdrawn from publication elsewhere. The authors should properly cite the publications that had an influence on the paper to avoid any suspicion of plagiarism.

The observance by the authors of high ethical standards is so vital to the whole scientific enterprise!
